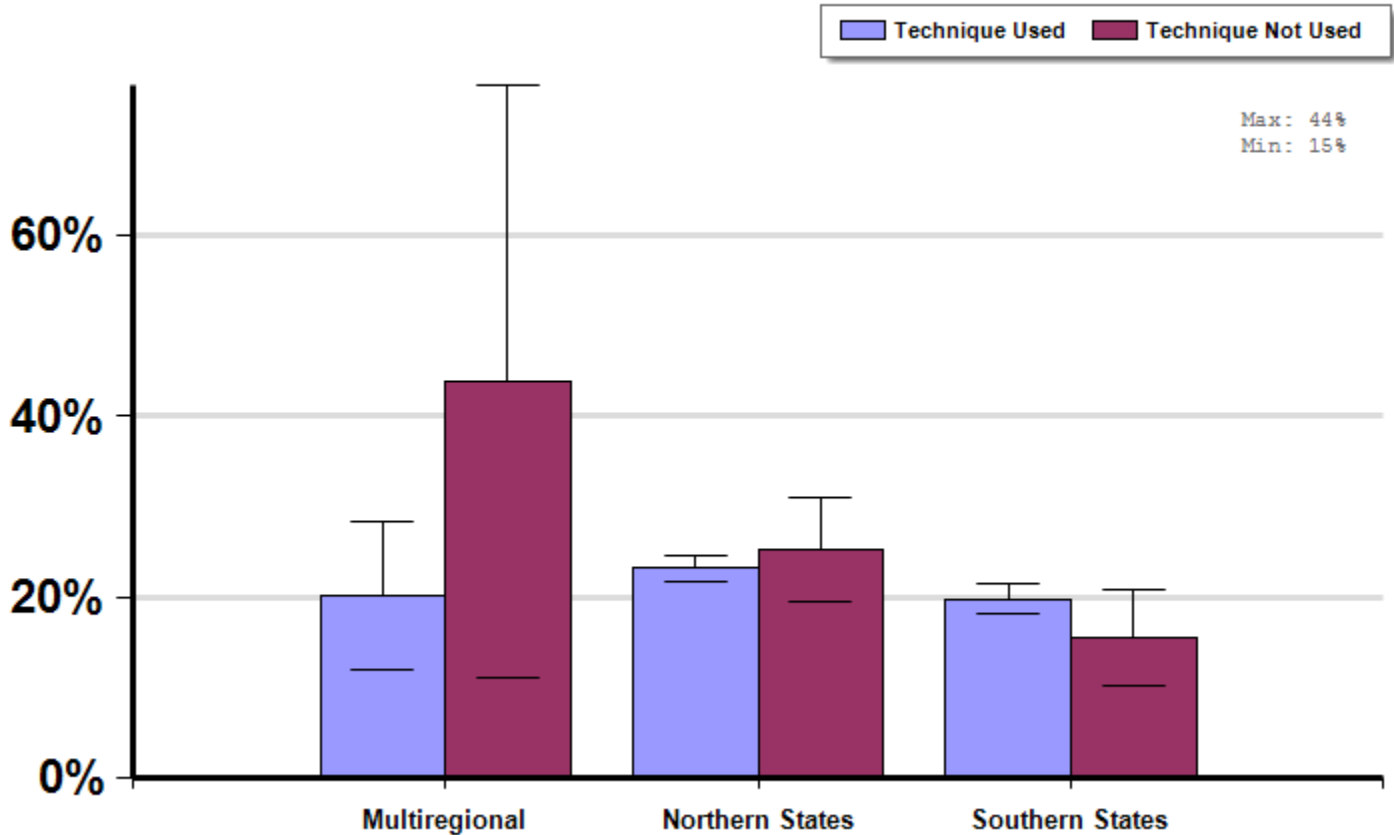

Average winter colony mortality reported by beekeepers that employed or did not employ screen bottom boards in their colonies between April, 2011 and March, 2012 by region of operation.

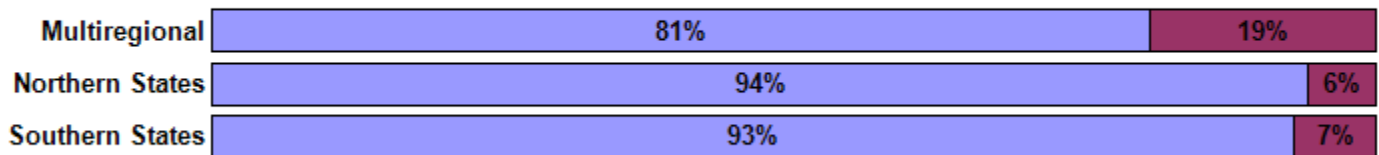
