



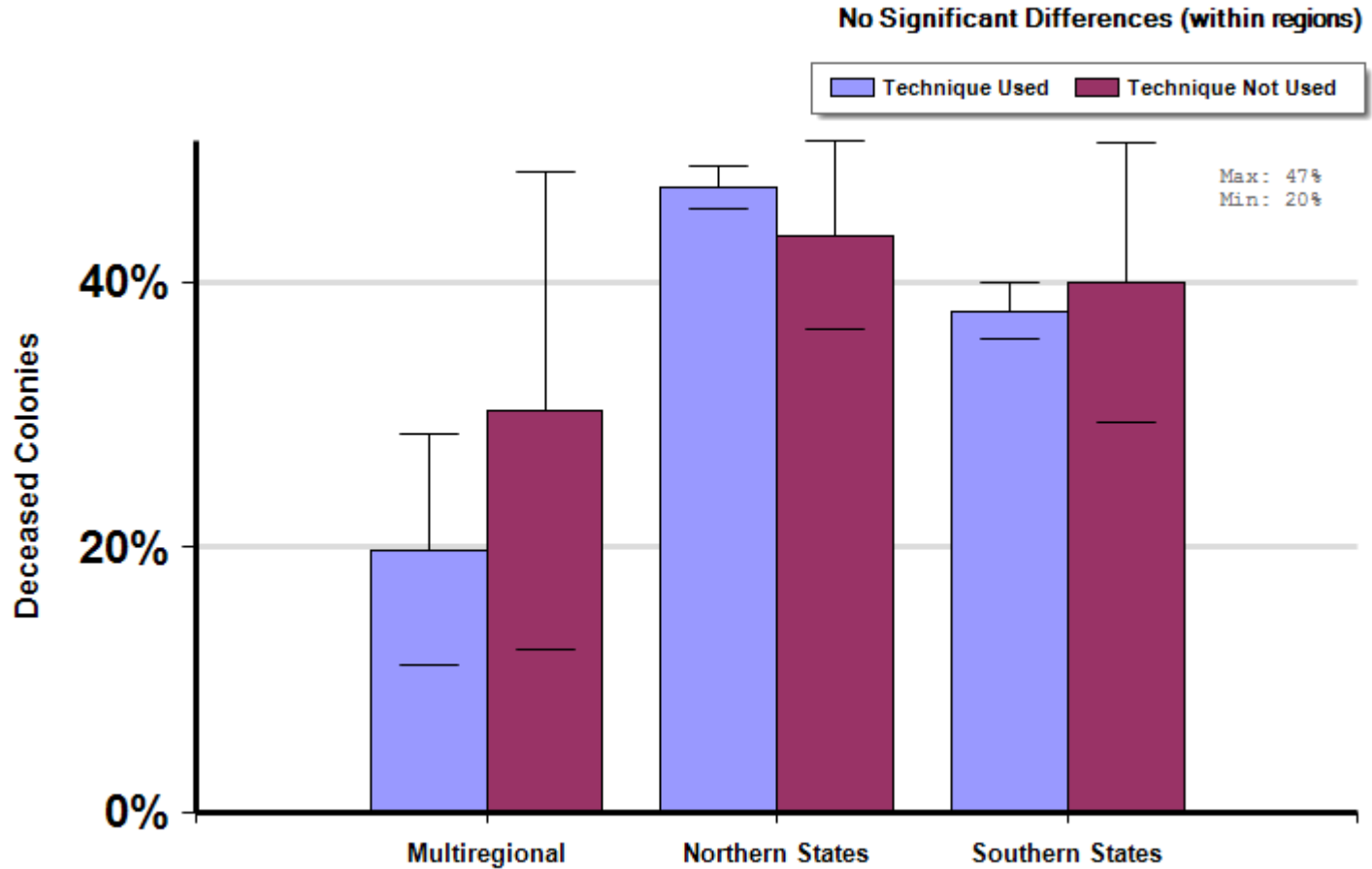
Screen Bottom Board Use By Region

Management Survey 2013

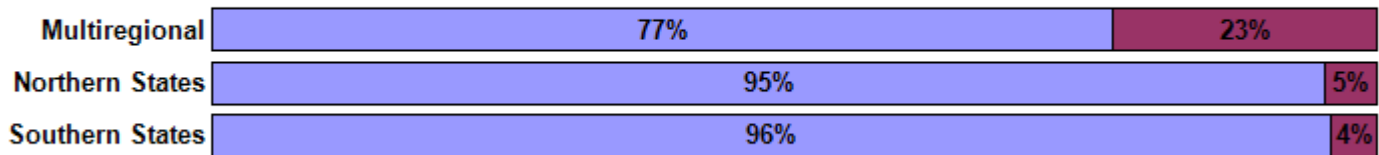
Average winter colony mortality reported by beekeepers that employed or did not employ screen bottom boards in their colonies between April and March by region of operation.
