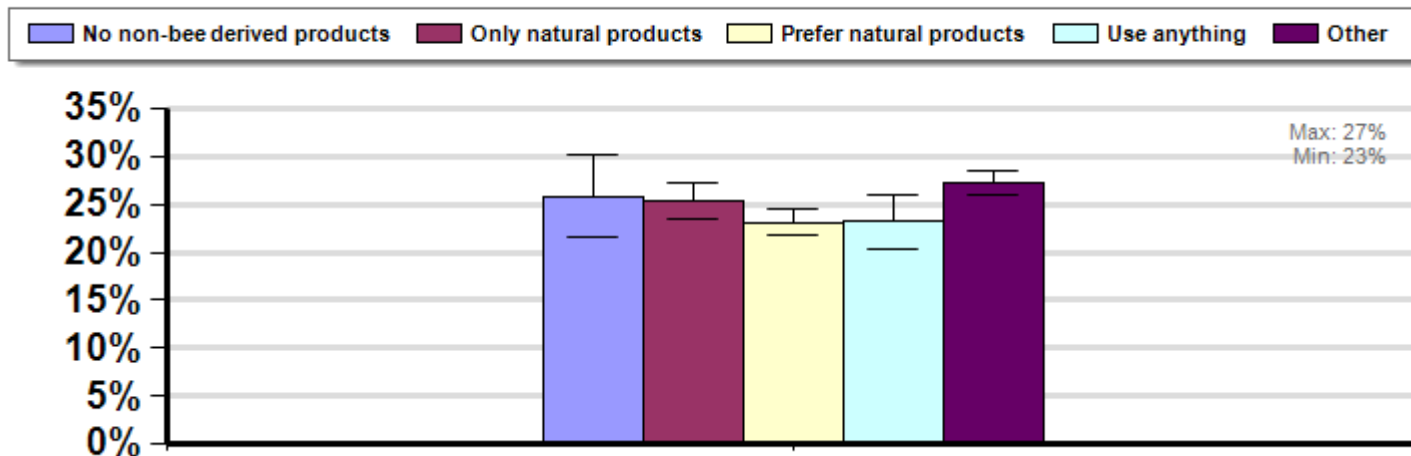

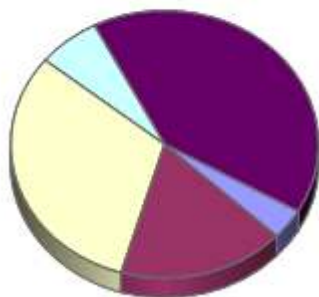
Average winter loss suffered by beekeepers who had different beekeeping management philosophies between April, 2011 and March, 2012.
