



Degree of Brood Comb Replacement By Region

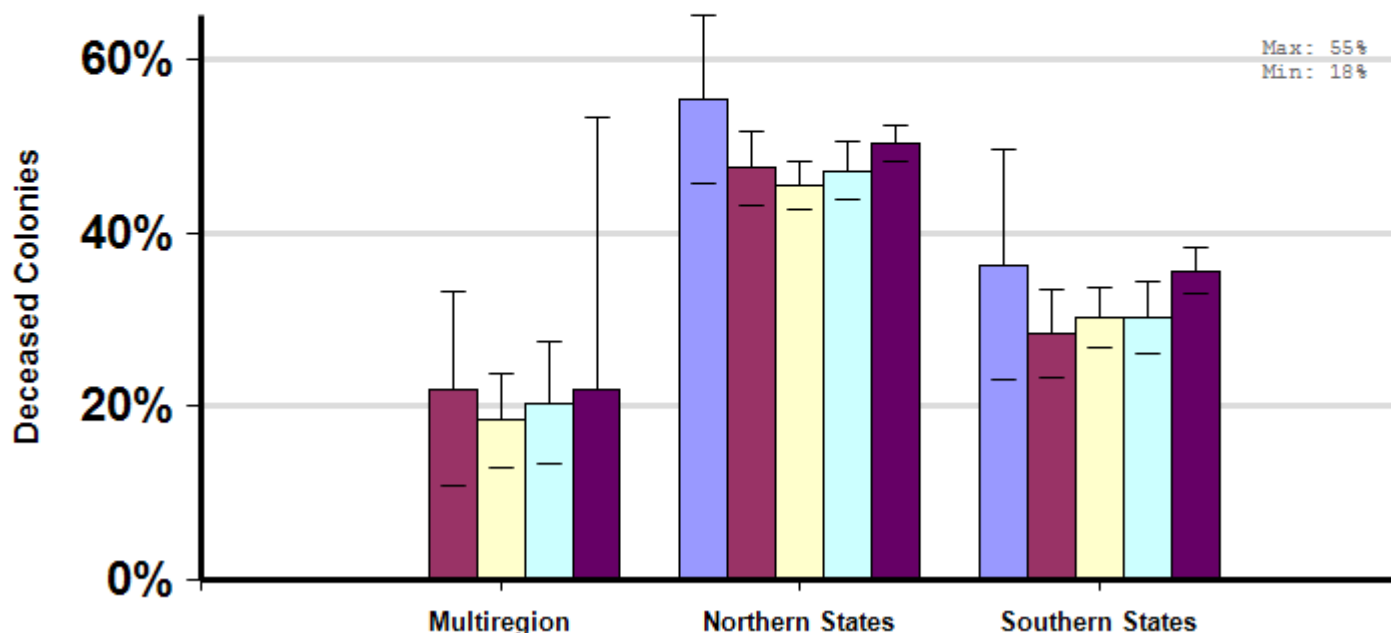
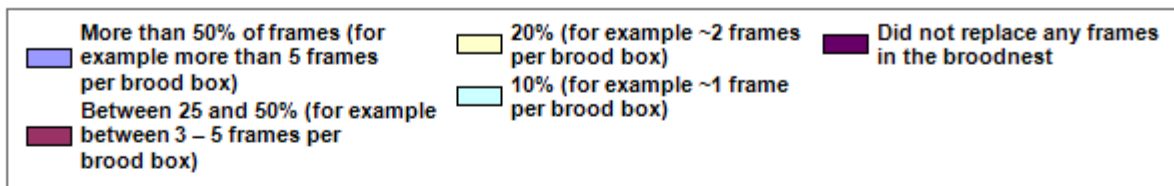

Average winter colony mortality suffered by beekeepers who replaced different percentages of their brood nest comb the previous year by region of operation.

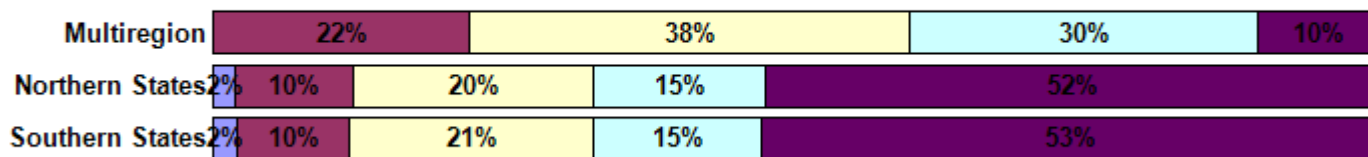

Some Significant Differences (within regions)

Interpretation

Beekeepers in the North who replaced 20% of the brood nest reported losing 4.8 fewer overwintering colonies (9.6% less deaths) than those who did not replace any brood frames in their colonies.

Survey Question

On average, how many frames from the brood nest of your colonies did you replace last year?

- Did not replace any frames in the brood nest
- 10% (for example ~1 frame per box)
- 20% (for example ~2 frames per brood box)

- Between 25 and 50% (for example ~3-5 frames per brood box)
- More than 50% of frames (for example more than 5 frames per brood box)
